The Countryside Adventure Competition at the Wintershill Estate is specifically designed to engage special needs pupils in the working countryside and their local rural community. With activities led by staff from the Estate, pupils get to meet and learn from the experts who work, manage and care for the farm animals, arable fields and wildlife.

The day also involves a number of expert volunteers who bring their animals and enthusiasm along each year, giving the children a very special day.

Each activity is designed to enable pupils to get as hands on as is safely possible, as they learn about how the countryside must be managed to ensure that it has a sustainable future.
